

Refrigerant Removal Certification Form

(For equipment normally containing < 50 lbs. of refrigerant)

A copy of this form must be filled out each time any equipment that contains refrigerant is disposed of. There are two options below. In general, if the technician who is disposing of the equipment finds refrigerant is left in the unit and properly removes it before disposal, check the first box. If the equipment was completely empty of refrigerant due to a leak, then the technician checks the second box.
